Illustrated Talk

On Monday **7 February 2022, Kingsdown Village Hall, 7:30pm** Gordon Wise will give a talk showcasing some of the research that has been done by the National Trust into the **Second World War History of the 540th Coast Regiment Royal Artillery** who manned the three gun sites of Fan Bay, South Foreland and Wanstone Farm. The three sites worked together as a unified command and hopefully by the end you will have an understanding of the guns, the actions and some of the stories and visits associated with the Regiment. The guns at Wanstone Farm were the largest guns mounted on UK soil. No booking necessary, just turn up.







Highlights of the Meeting of Walmer Parish Council held on Wednesday, 3rd November 2021 at Deal Parochial C of E School, Walmer.

Chairman's report: Cllr James Murray applauded the Climate Emergency Working Group following successful installation of the Drill Field EV charging points off Canada Road. An excellent example of how even small organisations can contribute towards helping the problems facing the planet re global warming.

Crime and anti-social behaviour: Members welcomed PCSO Kerry Skirrow who then provided a report on anti-social and criminal activities in Walmer.

Walmer in Bloom: Chair Cllr Mrs Sue Le Chevalier reported that while there would be no public award ceremony this year awards have been distributed by members of the team personally delivering awards to winners who were delighted to receive them.

Events Committee: Chair Cllr Marguerite Beard-Gould reported that plans for the Carols by Candlelight on December 18th are moving along well. The Christmas programme will be available at the next meeting.

Climate Emergency Working Group: Cllr John Lonsdale reported that the new Thermal camera had now arrived and staff training would begin shortly so that the Council could offer help to homeowners hoping to reduce their energy bills.

Report of The Clerk: New Logo for the Council: The Clerk gave a report on starting a design process which will be open to the public, replacing the old Council logo, with something that reflects Walmer in 2021. The designs specification will be broad but will take in both the built and natural environment of Walmer. The deadline for submitting designs will be 1st January 2022.

Staff report: The Clerk reported that the new trainee Deputy Town Clerk Mr Roland Aldred, had started work, was working well and was familiarising himself with the functions of the office. The Clerk explained that the Council had improved its secretariat/administration to a mainly full-time provision commensurate with the growing needs of the council and Walmer's rising population. The council had found that it was insufficiently resilient in the past.

The current establishment will have a self-generating succession capability built in which will cope far better with ever changing circumstances.

The Clerk outlined a proposal to extend and refit the rear ground floor room at no 62 into a conference room capable of holding all but the largest meetings in comfort and with the minimum of energy and carbon use.

Review of Governance Documents: The Clerk presented a report on the management of old documents and the resulting archive and members agreed that the suggested management method of digitising most records instead of destroying them completely be adopted and that the Council should introduce an online archive within its website

The Council wishes to record their condolences to the family of Sir David Amess, the MP who was murdered while doing his duty and asked the Clerk to write to the appropriate people to pass this on.



Walmer lifeboat volunteers have experienced a busy end to 2021 and start of 2022.

Volunteers left their Christmas Day celebrations responding to two paging alerts. The first call at 10.13am was after numerous 999 calls to the Coastguard about an empty rhib (rigid hulled inflatable boat) which was seen drifting in St Margaret's Bay. It was eventually found just outside Dover Harbour and was taken under tow into the harbour.



The second incident at just after 1.30pm was after a report of a person in the water just off Sandown Castle. The casualty unfortunately turned out to be a drifting deceased sheep. It was agreed with the Coastguard to let it wash ashore on the wind and tide to be dealt with by the appropriate authorities later.

Walmer's Lifeboat Operations Manager Denis Brophy said, 'Two shouts on Christmas Day is a first in my lifeboat career and I think a first for the station.' He asked that his thanks be passed on to the families and friends of crew who responded. The station's Area Lifesaving Manager Allen Head also added his thanks to the team and their families, commenting that they had shown the 'very best of selflessness' in their commitment.

2nd January saw the first call of the year when while exercise towards Dover Harbour crew saw a number of life jackets floating in the St Margaret's Bay area. A shoreline search was carried out but nothing was discovered, Five were recovered on the return journey and more were noticed under the cliff by The Monument. These were reported to the Coastguard to be collected by the Deal Coastguard Rescue Team later.

On returning from this call, crew were greeted by Sabrina Burford and Keith Ebdon from the P&O vessel Spirit of France. They presented the station with a cheque for £130, money raised from a Christmas raffle and quiz.

A wet, breezy and chilly Saturday 8 January saw volunteers and sponsor and local businessman Tom Ledger's Leaf Tree Services set about chipping a forest of Christmas trees for Walmer's third annual lifeboat fundraiser. Over 500 trees were chipped.

Prior to the event which was advertised as 'Recycle your tree to help save a life at sea', a compound was set up next to the lifeboat station on The Green to enable people to drop off their trees. A leafletting, banner and poster campaign around the town before Christmas, a live on BBC Radio Kent and the offer of a collection service by volunteers contributed to the number of trees recycled.

Over £2,000 has been raised by the event with more donations expected. The tree chippings are used for biofuel, a source of renewable energy, some of which goes to help power Discovery Park in Sandwich. Plans are already being discussed for a similar event next year. Walmer crew members Victoria Ward and Mark Rowley returned on 11 January from an intensive two-day Crew Emergency Procedures course at the RNLI College in Poole which forms part of their training development plan.

The course, which was a mixture of theoretical and practical training, began on Monday morning with a fire safety and pyrotechnics session. In the afternoon inshore lifeboat D Class and Atlantic capsized procedures were conducted in day and night-time conditions in the training pool at the College. Tuesday saw a full day learning sea survival theory with practical pool-based sessions. Later practical activities included swimming with and without life jackets then swimming in immersion suits. A simulated case study was undertaken which included 'jumping off a ship' from 4m board into the pool, entering life raft in simulated night and rough weather conditions before being rescued.

Speaking after the course, Victoria said, 'The experience was massively eye opening but fun, challenging yet highly rewarding. We both feel more confident moving forward in lifeboat careers'.

As always, Walmer lifeboat volunteers would like to thank the people of Walmer, Deal and the surrounding area for their continued support.

What is the Council doing about climate change?



Dover District Council has acknowledged the serious impact of climate change globally and in our everyday lives. The Council declared a Climate Change Emergency recognising the need for urgent action.

Outlined below are some of the current/ most recent initiatives and actions it has taken to reduce emissions:-

The Council has Grants/Schemes available to help residents in receipt of certain benefits, or on a low income with a vulnerability to living in a cold home (age/ health conditions) to improve the energy efficiency and increase the heat retention of their homes which decreases the need for energy and as a consequence reducing carbon emissions. More information can be found on the Council's website (<https://www.dover.gov.uk/Environment/Energy-Advice/Grant-Schemes.aspx>), or by calling 01304 872414.

New council housing built in the district will include solar Photovoltaics (PV), electric heating and provide additional insulation. These measures will significantly reduce the environmental impact of the developments and help reduce the long-term heating costs for the tenants.

The Council's Green Energy Grant Scheme is available for local businesses to help small businesses save carbon, become more energy efficient and save money. Recently DDC has given a grant of almost £10,000 towards the cost of new solar panels at a local farm shop.

Following a successful funding bid to the Office for Zero Emission Vehicles (OZEV), 49 electric vehicle charging points have been installed across the district (in car parks and on-street).

A new fleet of electric buses will operate on Dover Fastrack when it's launched in 2023, which will become Fastrack Kent's first zero-emission bus service.

Key works have been given the go ahead at St Margaret's Bay to help boost sea defences and continue to protect the area for the future.

Kearsney Abbey and Russell Gardens owned and managed by DDC have been awarded The Green Flag Award, in recognition of the enhancement of wildlife habitats, re planting the orchard, and the provision of facilities for people to learn about parkland heritage and biodiversity.

The Council celebrated National Tree Week by planting native trees to create a woodland walk at North Deal recreation ground. The trees offset the manufacture of 25 eco dog waste bins installed across the district by DDC. A further 14 trees gifted to the district from the Royal & Ancient following the 149th Open at Royal St George's have also been planted in Sandwich, at a community garden in Aylesham and Kearsney Parks adding to the 63 new fruit trees planted recently.

DDC will continue to take action to reduce emissions over which it has control and influence to meet the ambition of becoming a net zero emitter by 2030 and to support the district to become carbon neutral by 2050.
